Corinthian Spirit

By signing below you agree to adhere to the principles of the "Corinthian Spirit" and our Code of Conduct. We rely on each other to obey the rules and voluntarily take a penalty turn when we realize (or are reminded) that we've broken one. This voluntary aspect is called the "Corinthian Spirit," and is best expressed by the statement that you sail by the rules even when no one is looking. It also means, no yelling or swearing and no bullying your fellow sailor. The great sailor Paul Elvstrom said it best: "You haven't won the race, if in winning the race you have lost the respect of your competitors."

Code of Conduct

- Learn and sail by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)
- Call infractions only by hailing twice. (Example: "66 protests 55"; "66 protests 55").
- Acknowledge protests and perform penalty turns as soon as possible.
- Follow the Corinthian Spirit and do penalty turns, even when not protested.
- Show courtesy to your competitors and self control in your behavior and speech.
- Help new members with technical problems, sailing techniques or understanding the RRS.
- Remember, be a good sportsman, this is a fun sport.
