- Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing, as modified by Appendix E, the Sailing Instructions and the International Micro Magic Class Rules.
- Racing Format:** The Race Committee will determine the number of races after considering weather, course and equipment conditions. Three (3) races are to be completed to constitute a regatta. If there are more than 15 entries racing will be conducted under the P&R System. Trophies will be awarded to the top ~20% places .
- Frequency Assignment:** Participants should list all of their available radio frequencies on the regatta entry form.
- Sailing Instructions:** A copy of the Sailing Instructions will be e-mailed to all entrants after close of entries. Copies will also be made available at the Hotel for late entries.
- Inspection:** Boats may be inspected for conformance with International Micro Magic Class Rules on a random basis as determined by the Regatta Director. All boats must display sail numbers on both jib and main!
