



## Valentine's Day Regatta & Region 3B Championship Regatta February 18 & 19, 2012 Hosted by Palm Beach Gardens Model Yacht Squadron AMYA Sanctioned Club No. 94

- **Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing rules of sailing, as modified by Appendix E.
- Eligibility: The regatta is open to all boats recorded with the EC-12 Class.
- Schedule: Registration 8:30 AM Saturday Skippers meetings 9:00 AM Saturday, 9:00 AM Sunday Saturday races begin at 9:30 AM, No races will start after 3:30 PM. Sunday races begin at 9:30 AM, No races will start after 12:30 PM.
- Location: Lake Catherine, Palm Beach Gardens, FL
- **Entry:** Eligible boats may be entered by completing the attached Entry Form and submitting it prior to February 10, 2012 with an entry fee of \$30.00, guests \$8. Entry fee includes coffee, doughnuts, and drinks on Saturday and Sunday, plus lunch on Saturday
- **Scoring:** The regatta will be scored under the AMYA Heat Management System (P&R/EORS) using the Low Point Scoring method of RRS Appendix A. No seeding heats. Skippers will be placed in either the A- or B-fleet based on past performance to start the regatta. If at least 8 races are sailed, a boats worst score will be excluded. For every increment of 8 additional races sailed, one additional worst score will be excluded from her overall score.
- **Prizes:** Prizes will be awarded based on the number of entries received by the entry deadline: 3 prizes for 19 entries or less; 4 prizes for 20-26 entries; 5 prizes for 27 or more entries. Prizes will also include the "Ancient Mariner" prize for the highest finish by a skipper 70 years or older (who is not one of the top prize winners) and a Certificate for FREE entry into next year's regatta for the skipper who finishes last after completing the regatta.
