- Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, as modified by Appendix E.
- Eligibility:** The regatta is open to all boats recorded with the EC-12 Class.
- Schedule:** Registration 9:00 AM Saturday
Skippers meetings 9:30 AM Saturday, 9:00 AM Sunday
Saturday races begin at 10:00 AM, No races will start after 3:30 PM.
Sunday races begin at 9:30 AM, No races will start after 12:30 PM.
- Location:** Freedom Lake Park, Pinellas Park, Florida. Detailed directions will be provided with frequency assignments. GPS – N27.51.776 W082.42.856
- Entry:** Eligible boats may be entered by completing the attached Entry Form and submitting it prior to (March 19, 2010) with an entry fee of \$30.00, guests \$8. Entry fee includes coffee and doughnuts, lunch and drinks on Saturday.
Entries will be limited to the first 32 applications received.
- Scoring:** The regatta will be scored under Promotion / Relegation using the Low Point Scoring system of Appendix A. If at least 8 races are sailed, a boats worst score will be excluded. For every increment of 8 additional races sailed, one additional worst score will be excluded from her overall score.
- Prizes:** Prizes will be awarded based on the number of entries received by the entry deadline: 3 prizes for 19 entries or less; 4 prizes for 20-26 entries; 5 prizes for 27 or more entries. Prizes will also include the "Ancient Mariner" prize for the highest finish by a skipper 70 years or older (who is not one of the top prize winners) and a Certificate for FREE entry into next year's regatta for the skipper who finishes last after completing the regatta.
